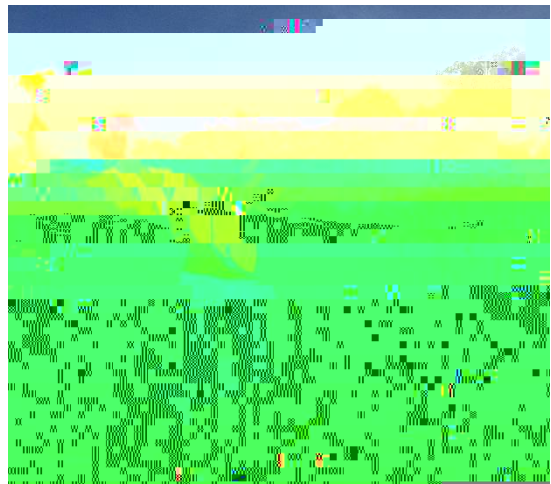

What is a highlight from your time in Geography 181 thus far? Measuring elevation change on the dunes.

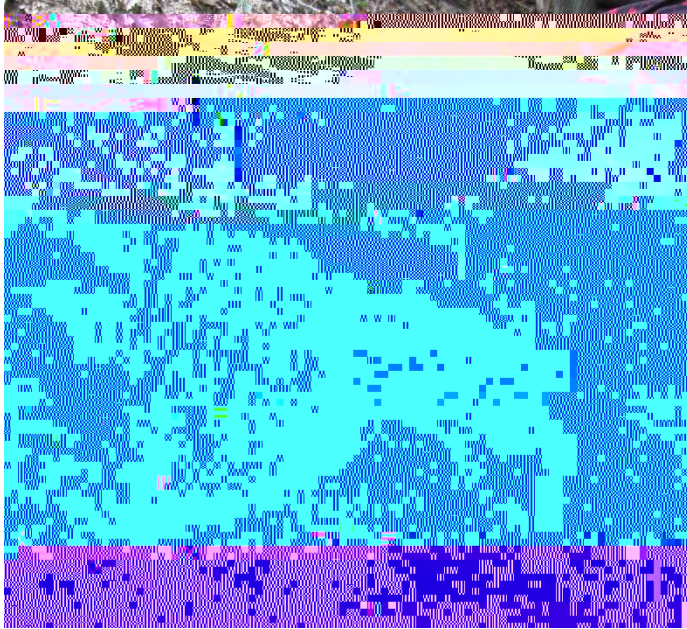

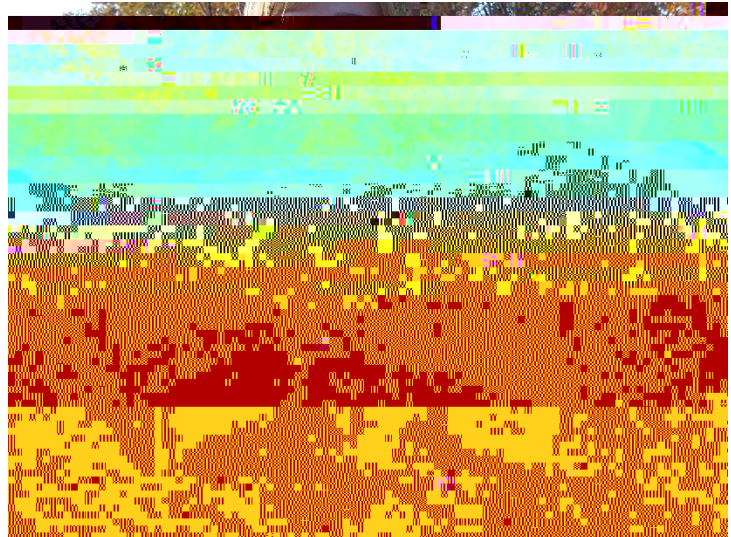

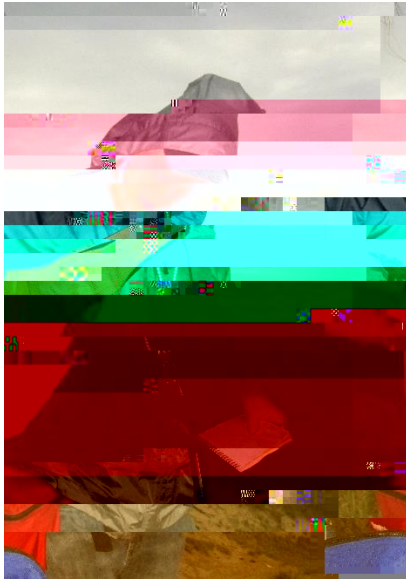
What is an interesting fact about you? I've recently started knitting.

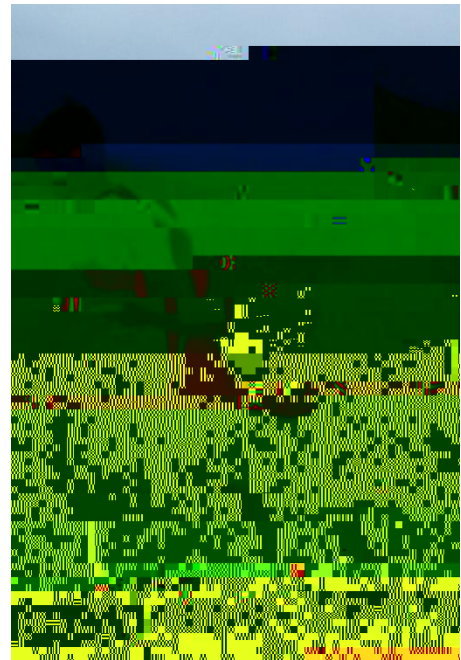
